# Community Transport

Community transport providers in Northamptonshire provide a valuable and often essential service to vulnerable people. Poor rural bus networks cause isolation and push more people into poverty.



Community transport schemes across Northamptonshire help 1000s of people reach doctors and hospital appointments and take them to fetch groceries.

More than ever your local community transport provider needs support. The story across the county is one of struggling organisations fighting for survival, short of funds, volunteer drivers and overwhelmed with demand.

## How can you help?

Can you volunteer time as a volunteer driver or in an admin role?

If you can afford to, make a donation to your local transport provider.

Contact your local councillor and let them know how important your transport scheme is to you.

# How to use this directory



1. Start by finding your parish or community, these are listed alphabetically from page 5. Schemes available in your community will be shown using a scheme number, in a small number of cases this may be blank indicating we are unaware of any schemes that may be operating in your community.

2. Each scheme has been allocated a scheme number, you can use this number to find out more information about the schemes in your area on pages 16 to 37.

3. We have broken the schemes up into 6 categories, you can find more about the types of scheme available on pages 4-6.

# Types of scheme



## Car Schemes



These offer a service for essential journeys when public transport is not an option. Journeys are traditionally for medical appointments although some providers do offer travel for other reasons. Transport providers usually need 48 hours notice of a journey in order to match a vehicle and driver. Drivers may act as escorts. Fares are based on mileage covered and some organisations may operate a membership scheme



## Dial-a-ride



This service offers a minibus (often with a passenger lift) when public transport is not an option. Usually they operate on local journeys and are booked in advance. Fares are either based on mileage covered or there is a set rate for a journey. Users of Dial-A-Ride may have to be members of the scheme. Some schemes can accept the concessionary bus passes

# Types of scheme



## Community minibus



These are registered local bus services and serve areas not covered by commercial bus operators. There are set fares for each journey covered. Some do accept Concessionary Bus Passes (after 09:30)



## Group travel/ hire



These schemes have a variety of vehicles including wheelchair accessible minibuses available for hire by Community Groups/Clubs with or without a driver. Costs are based on distance covered and time the driver is needed for. Some local trips can fit in around other journeys not requiring the driver to wait. Drivers must be MiDAS trained although some schemes can arrange training.



## Shopmobility




Shopmobility is a scheme that lends manual wheelchairs, powered wheelchairs and powered scooters to members of the public with limited mobility, to shop and to visit leisure and commercial facilities within a town, city or shopping centre.



Everyone is welcome, your local friendly Bus Service provides a service for your area. Payment for fares by cash or card and valid Concessionary Bus Passes are accepted.

The bus service is available across the rural communities of West Northamptonshire and Northampton South providing a weekly bus service to the main shopping areas of Daventry, Towcester, Brackley, Banbury and Northampton. The service operates 5 days a week.

ABILITY also offer an affordable PLUS service which allows for collection and drop off from home and shopping carried to your door. The PLUS service registration also gives priority access to trips, excursions, and lunch events around the county to help reduce social isolation and loneliness in rural communities.

Do you belong to a community Group? Local not-for-profit groups can book a minibus with a MiDAS trained and DBS Enhanced checked driver.

Minibus training through the Minibus Driver Awareness Scheme (MiDAS) is also available.

Home-to-town bus service, available to all 65 and over, or anyone with mobility issues in Daventry town - it's free! (in partnership with Daventry Town Council)

Every Friday morning, collecting individuals from their homes and dropping them off in the town centre - and later taking them home again.

## Car Scheme

Available to all 65 and overs, a Volunteer driver picks you up from your home, to take you to your Hospital, Health Centre, Optician or Dentist appointment, wait with you and bring you back, offering assistance along the way when needed. The cost is minimal to cover the drivers mileage.

We operate bus routes and pre-booked demand responsive transport (DRT) services across Northamptonshire (see the shaded region on the map below). Bus passes accepted during off-peak hours.

We prioritise group travel and our coordinator can organise trips for different communities, including (but not limited to) the following zones:

# Harborough Community Minibus



Harborough Community Bus (HCB) is a small charity local to Market Harborough which runs minibuses for community groups and certain individuals. It is not a typical "bus service" and is only available to be used by members.

They are a local charity and you or your group has to be from the Market Harborough area to join.

After that you can become a member if you are a community group or need transport because of age, sickness, disability or poverty.

They charge a small amount to cover the running costs of the buses. Typically, this is about £30 for something local around Harborough. For longer trips it works out just over £1.00 per mile for the round trip. For the journeys they regularly travel, they have a list of prices.



This scheme is for elderly and/ or disabled people who live within the town of Northampton (postcodes NN1-NN5), who are unable to drive and have difficulty using public transport, to get to their medically-related appointments. The volunteer drivers work Monday to Friday only, except bank holidays.

The scheme is also able to do some 'long distance' journeys to medical appointments in neighbouring counties. The scheme now has a wheelchair accessible vehicle for use by those who are unable to transfer into a car seat.

There is an annual registration fee on £35. The volunteer drivers are paid 45p/mile for the part of the journey when the passenger is not in the vehicle and 50p/mile once the passenger has been collected. This covers the volunteer drivers' running costs. There is a minimum charge of £2.50 per journey. A member of staff will discuss your eligibility and explain the scheme. A registration form will be sent to you for completion.

Northampton Door to Door Service offer supportive transport on adapted minibuses for residents in the 'borough' of Northampton. This service operates 5 days a week (Mon-Fri, except bank holidays). This includes a dedicated shopping bus to most major supermarkets. Passengers can request their preferred destination which can include day centres, social visits, shopping and more.

There are two services:

1. A basic Demand Response Service (DRS) which is free of charge to join for non-assisted travel. The minibus will arrive at the appointed time at a place nearest to the passenger's address. They will wait for a few minutes and then move onto the next pick up. These journeys can be booked one-day in advance.
2. A full NDDS membership is £35 per year and is a door to door service where the drivers will pick up from the member's address (or a specified location), help them to and from the minibus, assist with shopping on and off the bus and to the front door, if required. Full NDDS members can also book the shopping service and lunch club outings.

Users no longer travel for free with a valid bus pass, there is a £1 charge for each leg of the journey. Please note: full fares apply before 09:30. Everyone who wishes to use NDDS is required to be a member

Peel Centre & Asda Corby Retail Park – Every Friday (excluding bank holidays) departing Rushton Village at 10:00. A shopping trip that provides a choice of supermarkets and a selection of different retail outlets. Returning to Rushton at 12:30.

## Community Trips:

Community trips undertaken either occasional to special shopping events or visits to places of interest including coffee, snacks, or meals These trips are advertised in the Triangle Parish Magazine, Parish Notice boards and posting on the Rushton Village Support WhatsApp group that also provides updates.

# Callconnect Service

20

CallConnect is a public bus service that operates in response to pre-booked requests.

Registration is free but you must be a member to book a journey. You can then use the service for any reason and as frequently as required. The fully accessible minibuses operate from 7am to 7pm, Monday to Friday, and from 7.30am to 6.30pm on Saturdays, with some local variations.

In most cases, CallConnect will pick up and set down at designated locations in each village or town.

Passengers with a disability or those living in more isolated locations can be picked up and returned to their home address, if it is safe and practical to do so.

You can use CallConnect to travel anywhere within each service's operating area. You can also use it to connect with the main Interconnect bus service or other bus and train services.

Concessionary bus passes are valid on all services.
